Dear Mr. Hurst:

This is in response to the above referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. Specifically, you requested a listing of the design, operating, and total capacities of all BOP facilities and all facilities privately contracted by the BOP.

In response to your request, staff located 10 pages of responsive records, which were forwarded to this office for a release determination. After careful review, we determined 10 pages are appropriate for release in full. The Bureau of Prisons (BOP) uses rated capacities, not design capacities. A total of the rated capacities may be calculated from the attached documents. Additionally, the BOP has no access to design capacities for Private Prisons. You will need to contact them directly.
