FCI Terminal Island (Low)
USP Terre Haute (Minimum, Medium, and High)
USP Tucson (High)

CARE Level 4 Facilities

FMC Butner
FMC Carswell
FMC Devens
FMC Lexington
FMC Rochester
USMCFP Springfield

* Note: Although an inmate's CARE Level assignment is a major criteria in determining the appropriate BOP designation, it is

only one factor.

It is important to note that CARE Level assignment institutions are subject to change as the BOP continues to evaluate the optimum distribution of CARE Levels to meet inmate health care needs.
